### ERA offers scholarships to legal practitioners from the Western Balkans, Moldova and Ukraine

For more than 30 years the Academy of European Law (ERA) has been bringing together lawyers, judges, in-house counsel and other legal practitioners from all across Europe for training in European law.

ERA runs a scholarship programme to ensure that all legal practitioners from EU Member States and candidate countries have the same opportunity to participate in professional training on European law.

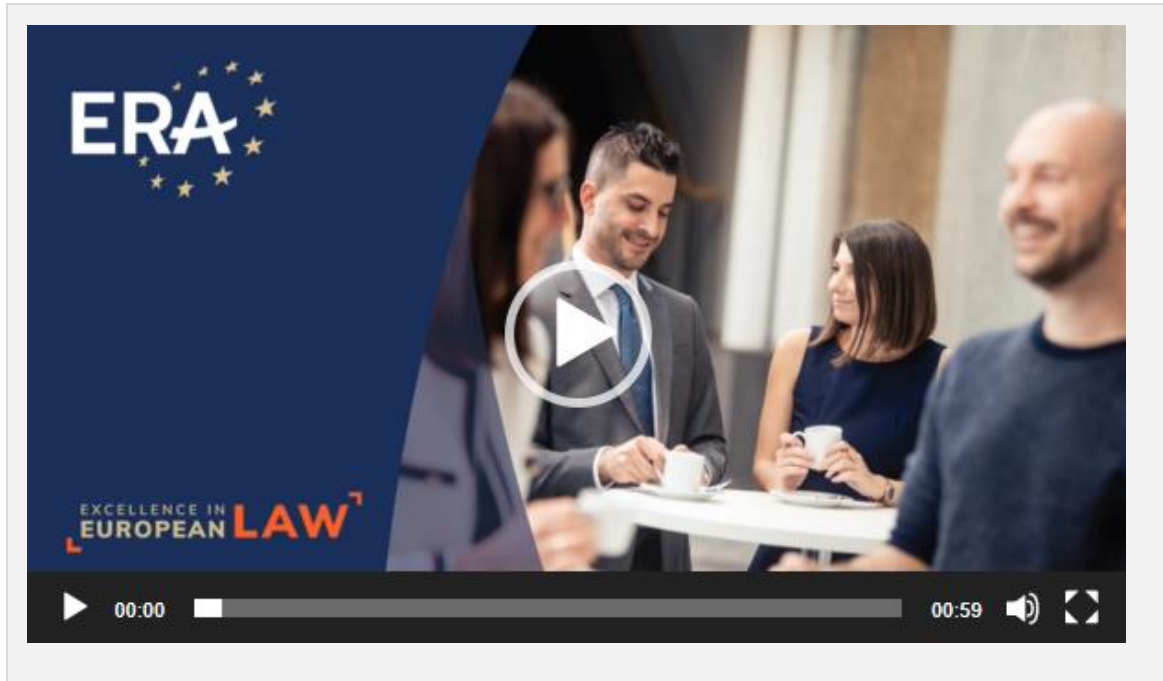
ERA is now inviting applications for scholarships primarily (but not exclusively) from the Western Balkan countries – **Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo\***, **Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia** – as well as **Moldova** and **Ukraine**.

The scholarship can cover up to the full costs of participation in one of the [upcoming events listed here](#) for the year 2024.

Applications must be submitted at the latest two months (for face-to-face attendance) or one month (for online events) before the conference.

- Successful applicants will be asked to deliver a report on how they made use
