

The usual format is for expert panels to discuss the use of English law covering topics such as:

- methods for avoiding disputes;
- international arbitration and dispute resolution;
- UK claims involving foreign parties.

The conferences attract senior representatives and general counsel from leading companies, law firms, financial institutions, advisory firms and organisations from both England and Wales and the host country.

English Law Days are a fantastic opportunity for lawyers from around the world to meet with English legal practitioners, to share expertise and develop international business relationships.

As part of this we are looking to attract solicitors and barristers to speak at the conference along with forensic accountants, investigators and top foreign qualified lawyers.

The Forum also provides the chance to spend concerted time with peers and local experts to generate referrals of work on matters where there are synergies between our respective practices.
